Respond to inquiries regarding ethical issues.

Develop and review SCA policies regarding ethical issues or behavior for the Officers and/or Board of Directors.

Review the scientific program committees and SCA CME activities for disclosure of conflicts of interest as directed by the Board and CME committee.

Review and resolve complaints made against members, and other mandates as directed the Board of Directors or Officers of the SCA.

- 2. Respond to 100% of the ethical inquiries directed to the committee by the SCA BOD/President by acknowledged deadlines

- 4. Develop and/or review SCA policies regarding ethical issues yearly prior to the annual meeting
