2024-25 Benchmarks

(Action items for upcoming year)

- 1. Learning Management System: Complete a due diligence review for cost vs. services for subscription based learning management systems for SCA University and report (including cost analysis) to the BOD recommendations (Continuing with Efront or an additional product)
- Anesthesia Review Course: Release five additional modules, develop a question bank implementation plan and successfully enroll 100 additional individuals in the course. Finally, will endeavor to provide an impact of SCA membership growth secondary to the member benefit of ARC
- 3. Clinical Updates: Production and release of five clinical updates from SCA committees, task forces, SIG's, etc. Promote and successfully enroll 50 SCA members in each course
- Professional Development Webinars: Production and release of three faculty development webinars and three resident/fellow programs. Promote and successfully enroll 10 percent more attendees
- 5. Interdisciplinary Webinars: Development and release of a biannual webinar. Promote for engagement with 100 SCA members
- 6. Journal Club Webinars: Create an infrastructure with the research committee a biannual webinar presenting subspeciality cutting edge research and panel discussion
- 7. Quality Patient Safety Program: Work with the QSV committee to create an SCA University Program with resources regarding creating quality projects
