Committee Charge

The mission of the SCA Scientific Program Planning Committee is to maintain the quality of the scientific content of the Annual Meeting & Workshops and ensure consistency, continuity, and balance in the programming to meet the needs of the Annual Meeting Attendees and SCA membership.

Goals of the SCA Scientific Program Planning Committee:

- To design the overall program for the Annual Meeting.
- Submit and review session proposals, and decide format and content for the annual meeting program.
- Develop fellowship track programming for trainees at the Annual Meeting
- Coordinate Scientific Abstract program to select scientific work to be presented at the Annual Meeting
- Develop Workshops and Problem-Based Learning Discussion sessions for attendee.
- To determine the basic schedule for the main conference events, working within the constraints of the facility and SCA's budget.
- Identify and select the moderators and speakers for the sessions, workshops and Problem-Based Learning Discussions.
- Coordination of industry support for educational programming, when appropriate.
- Participate in various roles (e.g., moderator) on-site at the Annual Meeting, review conference evaluations and offer suggestions for future programs accordingly.

2025-26 Benchmarks (Action items for upcoming year)

- 1. Develop 2026 Annual meeting program content, based on committee member-generated sessions and working in collaboration with appropriate councils, committees, and interest groups.
- 2. Identify faculty for 2026 Annual Meeting.
- 3. Reconcile Annual Meeting planning with recommendations from the BOD, including budgetary directives. Areas of focus identified for 2026 include, but are limited to, engagement of critical care and private practice.
- 4. Quarterly Meetings with Scientific Program Committee to debrief 2025 meeting, review future program development, and expand input from the committee.
- 5. Develop processes for expanded member engagement in Annual Meeting content selection: Survey of Member Needs for Annual Meeting (PBLD submissions, general session proposals, networking events).
- 6. Increase coordination of content with the Online Education Committee.
- 7. Continue to expand meeting offerings by coordinating with internal and external entities to develop original content for SCA members, such as the Innovation Session and International Symposium.
